


Journalists faced obstruction and violence following local elections

- 7 taken into custody
- 6 physical assault
- 4 attack to property
- **3** *verbal attack*

In April, journalists in eastern Turkey <u>faced</u> <u>attacks</u> and obstruction while covering public protests against a decision by electoral authorities blocking the newly elected mayor of Van, Abdullah Zeydan, from taking office.

Several journalists were injured by plastic police bullets or water cannons, while others faced death threats or were harassed on social media for their reporting.
